

In the 17th and 18th century, there were over 3,000 windmills in Flanders. Most were built out of wood and were on a pivot. They were used to grind wheat and dry out the marshes. Some mills have been restored and still manufacture oil and flour.

So do not forget to visit the *Casteel Meulen* in Cassel, you will leave the museum with a bag of flour produced in the mill.

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
