

The museum of Flanders, located on the Grand'Place of Cassel, opened on October 23, 2010.

Unique in Europe, the museum invites you for an exciting journey through mysterious Flanders.

By means of an original scenography, objects from the war period and even paintings, let's discover an unknown chapter of History: the organization of the rear front in Flanders during the World War I.
